

Language of My Learning

Adults will provide opportunities for you to learn the correct technical words, investigate and use more challenging language and develop your ability to read, speak aloud and have wide-ranging discussions. Adults will have high expectations and will constantly focus on improving the quality of your language use.

Adults will support you in the process of developing your thinking so that you learn to use mistakes and challenges to improve – because you believe that you can! You ask questions and always want to know why and how.

Word Master

You are able to investigate and use high quality language and use the correct technical vocabulary.

You are able to share your opinions through good quality discussion and confidently ask questions so that you can learn more and share ideas.

Empathy

You show consideration for how others are feeling and think about why others act the way they do. You reflect on the needs of other people and do what is reasonable to support your friends and others around you. You try to treat other people in a way that you would like to be treated.

Growth Mindset

You talk about and respond to challenges in a way that shows you can learn from mistakes. You show self-belief and determination to try again, improve and use challenges to develop your knowledge, skills and understanding.

Big Ideas

You learn new things, improve your knowledge and skills and link ideas creatively from different subject areas. You show aspiration to learn about and do new things and show determination to do well and achieve. You are inspired by new things!

Language of My Feelings

Adults will provide opportunities for you to develop empathy, language to describe your feelings and emotional resilience. They will help you think about how you feel and support you in using the correct words to express your emotions. You will learn to consider how others are feeling and manage your own emotional responses during disagreements. You will be supported to take responsibility for your own actions and learn to establish and maintain good relationships with those around you.

Language of My Future

Adults will provide opportunities for you to develop new skills and knowledge in different subjects and areas of interest. You will be supported to use these skills in new and challenging ways across the curriculum in different contexts. You will be taught about local, national and global issues that affect people – with a particular focus on science and technology. Adults will help you develop your understanding of other places, cultures, ways of life and experiences. You will learn that you can and should influence the world around you.
