

### English

As young writers we will be introduced to a variety of text types. We will be writing recounts including diary entries. We will begin to explore character description using the senses and creating a wanted poster for a super villain. We will begin to explore the complex ability of story telling and even write our own version of a story we know and writing the next adventure for a superhero. Near the end of the term we will begin the exciting journey of becoming poets and explore the theme of rhythm and rhyme. Each day we will continue to have our daily phonics lessons and reading in groups a variety of text types including fiction and non-fiction.



### Mathematics

As young Mathematicians we will be exploring 2D shapes including naming and describing them. We will be investigating the term place value from counting to and across 100 and practice counting in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s. We will be learning about the complicated ideas of time and using time words like first, second and even learning the days of the week and months of the year.



### Science

As scientists we will be exploring the interesting topic of "Animals including humans." This covers a mass of interesting concepts. We will look at the human body and begin to name and know the parts of the body and understand which parts of the body are linked with the 5 senses. We will explore the needs of animals (including ourselves) covering the importance of exercise and eating healthily.

### Computing

As you computer users we will learn how to use them safely including logging onto the computer, finding and retrieving information from a variety of sources. We will begin to understand the concept of algorithms.

### History

As Historians we will be exploring the idea of real life superhero's and within the context of the Crimean war we will look at the famous nurse Florence Nightingale. We will look at life as a child in Victorian Britain.

### Art

As Artists we will be producing self portraits and using paints to color in the different features. We will be exploring the use of sculptures and creating some in the form of different familiar animals.

### Wider Curriculum

Within the wider curriculum we will cover subjects including music, PE, PSHE and RE. Within these subjects we will be exploring a variety of ideas from looking at family and who is important to us and looking at the ideas of rules and why we have them.

### Geography

As geographers we will be looking at maps and looking at naming and locating a range of key countries. We will also be looking at naming a range of key oceans across the globe.
