Dear Parents and Carers,

Just a quick letter to mention a few important points.

CORONAVIRUS ADVICE

The advice from Public Health England is changing on a weekly basis but the main messages remain the same – ‘don’t panic and be sensible’. The advice is for everyone to continue as normal. The most important learning for children is about hand washing hygiene. In this respect, we are encouraging the children to do the same usual things such as making sure they wash their hands after using the bathroom, before eating and ensuring they catch sneezes (with a tissue), bin it and then wash their hands again. The children have been reminded to wash their hands regularly to minimise germs and are being shown how to do this properly. We currently do not have any children or staff members who have been anywhere near any areas in the world where there has been an outbreak. If any advice changes we will be made aware of this and let you know. I have attached the Public health poster to this letter and we will put this up around school.

WORLD BOOK DAY

Just to remind you about World Book Day on Thursday. Children can come dressed as a favourite book character.
