Please do not allow children to bring any other equipment to school apart from reading books, water bottle and packed lunch (if applicable).



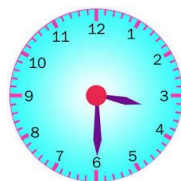
Start times

Key Stage 2 arrive 8.45 – 8.55 (latest)
Key Stage 1 arrive 9.00 – 9.15 (latest)
If you have children in both key stages, please bring them all at the later time.



End times

Key Stage 1 leave 3.00 – 3.15
Key Stage 2 leave 3.30
If you have children in both key stages, please come at 3.30 to collect all children. Key Stage 1 children with siblings will stay in their class until key stage 2 come out



Water Bottles

Water bottles for class must only contain **water**. These will be able to be refilled from our super new water coolers.

These staggered times are to help everyone to maintain social distancing around school. This is so important to help us keep everyone safe and for school to remain fully open.

Forest School



We are changing our forest school schedule next term and will be beginning with Years 5 and 6 in term 1. To begin with, children should wear their forest school kit to school. Year 5 will be in the morning initially and should bring a change of trousers in the event of forest school trousers getting muddy. Forest school begins in week 2 – Thursday 10th September.

Breakfast and After School Club

These provisions will both begin again from Wednesday 2nd September. Children will be offered a pre-packaged snack for both sessions such as brioche or cereal bars and a drink. We will keep key stage 1 and key stage 2 as separate as we can within the room. After school club will run Monday to Thursday as usual. Please settle any outstanding payments from last term before booking in new dates.



Bubbles and Pods

As far as possible, children will remain within their class pods and will not mix freely with other classes. However, to enable us to function as a school with the number of staff we have, two pods will join together into a bubble for play and for lunch and will share toilet facilities. So Years 1 and 2 will be a bubble, Years 3 and 4 will be a bubble and Years 5 and 6 will be a bubble. EYFS will remain a pod on their own initially.
