Candidates will show good personal emotional literacy as well an ability to personalise learning when necessary in order to meet the child's needs, working effectively as part of a staff team and communicating well with parents. They will be able to support learning plan targets effectively.

They will be good at establishing clear and firm boundaries with the pupil and remaining calm and reassuring in situations. They will remain optimistic and positive in challenging situations and be willing to find alternative strategies to break through barriers and negative behaviour patterns.

- a flexible and resourceful approach to your teaching.
