Dear parents and carers,

Following government guidance and advice from South Gloucestershire public health, we are going ahead with our Christmas performances (nativity and carols by candle light) with additional measures in place to safeguard the community. Although we do still have cases in the school, these haven't continued to rise as rapidly as we have seen in previous weeks. Of course, performances going ahead are subject to there being no further changes in local or national guidance before the dates of the performances.

In order to keep the community safe during the performances, we would need all audience members attending to follow the guidelines below, set out in our risk assessment, which seek to reduce movement and enable ventilation:

- We would ask that all adults attending undertake a lateral flow test before and only attend if this is negative.
- All audience members to wear a mask (unless exempt) and remain seated.
- No refreshments will be provided in order to reduce movement.
- Windows and doors will be open to increase ventilation – the hall is a large space and can enable good ventilation. CO2 monitor will be used to check that conditions are good. Therefore, please ensure you are wearing layers as it is likely to be cold in the hall.

We will also produce recorded versions of the performances for those who do not wish to, or not able to, attend. The videos will be shared via Google Classroom and Tapestry.
