



MATHEMATICS

As Mathematicians, we will be focusing on place value within 20 representing, comparing and ordering numbers. Additionally, we will learn to use different strategies for addition and subtraction within 20 using practical equipment such as number lines, tens frames and part-whole plates.

ENGLISH

As Writers, we will be using Jack and the Beanstalk and Little Red Riding Hood to inspire us for our term focus on fairytales. We will focus on consolidating the objectives that we have covered so far, sequencing sentences to form short narratives and using question marks.

SCIENCE

As Scientists, we will be focussing on materials. We will learn that objects are made out of a range of materials and understand why they are used. Additionally, we will describe, group and compare different materials and objects according to their properties.

READING

As Readers, we will be focusing on fluency and being able to decode 90% of the words on the page. We will also use our phonics to decode words with phase 5 sounds in them including new alternative pronunciations. We will discuss what we have read particularly, the moral messages in the books taking turns to voice our opinions and listening to what others say.
