Large scale painting with water and big paintbrushes Safety transporting equipment in the loose part play Threading
Cutting skills
Pencil grip and control
Letter formation

#### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term we will be looking at Celebrating differences. We will be thinking about things that are the same and things that are different and celebrating these.

We will continue to focus on our three school rules:

Safe, Kind and Useful.

It can be difficult when things don't go our way so we will continue to talk about this and about ways we can deal with these situations.

#### **Maths**


This term in maths we will be looking at

and concepts.


# Lets celebrate! Kipling class - term 2

## **Understanding the World**

This term we will be finding out about how people celebrate different festivals around the world. We will be looking at maps to help us locate these places. ### **English**

We will continue to develop the children's love of reading by sharing many stories. During these times we will be developing the children's understanding of characters, setting and plot. We will continue to learn phonic sounds and will be using these to read and write words and sentences. The children will be writing lists and captions during adult directed sessions. However there will also be lots of opportunities for the children to write in their play.

## **Expressive Arts and Design**

This term we will be using different materials to create pieces of art; paint, paper, clay. We will be trying out different techniques to see what effects we can create. We are also learning lots of songs ready for our Christmas performance on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> December.
