



MATHEMATICS

As Mathematicians, we be consolidating partitioning two numbers, fact families and counting back. We will learn to use the subtraction sign to form simple number sentences, find the difference and compare with addition statements. Lastly, we will learn to sort and recognise 2D and 3D shapes.

SCIENCE

As Scientists, we will continue to explore the five senses. We will also be observing changes in trees at this time of the year, as well as comparing the seasons using our senses.

<u>ART/DT</u>

As Artists, we will be learning how to draw different leaves, focusing on adding detail and the best media to use to create them. We will apply our seasons knowledge to our artwork. As designers, we will be continuing our work on different joining techniques. We will create Christmas crafts in our workshop area.
