'Moving up morning' – Wednesday 2nd July 2025

Transition can be a tricky time for children; we would like for them to be as prepared as possible for the change in September. All class teachers will talk to the children about transition and change. Some children may need additional support around transition; we have plans in place for this and the class teacher will contact parents/carers if they feel that more support may be beneficial. If parents/carers have concerns or worries about transition, please speak to your child's teacher.

Children will start the day in their normal classes so should be dropped off to the usual place.

After a short assembly, the children will go with their new teacher to their new classroom. The morning will be used to get to know their classroom and new teacher.

After lunch, the children will return to their normal class so are to be collected from the normal pick-up point.

Any Y6 children not involved in transition day on Wednesday 2nd July should come to school in forest clothing as normal.
